**AUCTION NOTICE**

**NOTICE FOR DISPOSAL OF THE CONFISCATED RICE LYING IN THE  
CENTRAL WARE HOUSING CORPORATION, PUDUCHERRY.**

On behalf of the President of India, the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry invites applications from the Rice Millers/Dealers/Traders, Retail/Whole sale Rice Merchants or Firms for disposal of confiscated rice in seven lots presently stocked at Central Ware Housing Corporation, Vanarapet, Uppalam, Puducherry as mentioned in the schedule-I & II on Open auction.

2. The sale of confiscated rice in seven lots shall be conducted by the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry. The intending bidders shall offer their bids on the total upset price (assessed value) of the rice for the lot offered by him.

3. The intending bidder should submit the application to the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs, Puducherry on or before **3.00 pm on 27.10.2015** with all required documents as mentioned in sale Appendix "A" of this Auction Notice for consideration. The document received after **3.00 p.m. on 27.10.2015** will not be considered.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5. The terms and conditions, governing the sale are given in Appendix "A". Tenderer should pay the Earnest Money Deposit either for one lot or for more lots given in Appendix "C". In case, any condition is attached, the Tender application will be summarily rejected.

6. Earnest Money Deposit:

Earnest Money Deposit must be accompanied with each tender as stipulated in the terms and conditions.

7. Sample of stocks

The stocks may be inspected by the intending Tenderers on the authority of the letter issued by the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry at the Central Ware Housing Corporation, Vanarapet, Puducherry on any working day from 28.09.2015 to 13.10.2015 between 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. from where the delivery of the stocks shall be given.

8. Signing of Tender:

Persons signing the Tender should state in what capacity he or she is signing the Tender (i.e.,) sole Proprietor of a firm, or Secretary, Managing Director, etc., of a Limited company. In case of partnership firm, the Tender must be signed by all partners. The person signing the Tender form or other documents forming part of Tender on behalf of another shall produce a proper Power of Attorney duly executed in his favour stating that he had authority to bind such other person in all matters pertaining to the contract. If the person signing subsequently fails to produce the said Power of Attorney within a reasonable time, the Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs may without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs and damages. The Power of Attorney should be signed by all partners in case of partnership concern and in case of Limited Companies it should be under the common seal of the company.

9. Submission of Tender:

(a) The Tender application should be submitted in the prescribed form in **Appendix- "B" along with Appendix "A" duly signed, Appendix "C" with Banker's Cheque / Demand Draft for EMD amount, Xerox copy of cash receipt towards the cost of Application form issued by this Office.**

(b) The number of Lots offered and the last date of submission should be shown on the envelope and it should be addressed to the Director, Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Thattanchavady, Puducherry – 605 009. Tender application will be received upto 3.00 p.m. on the above specified date.

(c) Tenderers wishing to deposit their Application by hand should deposit them in the Tender box provided at the Office of the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry for the purpose not later than 3.00 p.m. on the above specified date.

(d) Tender and / or amendments submitted after **completion of open Auction** on the scheduled date and time will not be considered. A Certificate to the effect that your firm is licensed as Rice miller, Retail / wholesale Rice Merchants / Dealers or Firm etc., should accompany Tender. The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry has option to accept or reject a Tender in consultation with the Disposal Committee on the date and time as mentioned in the Scheduled-I & II.

(e) The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry reserves the right to stop/cancel the sale of auction of **any lot(s)** of the confiscated rice without assigning any reason before conduct of auction and a final list of lots of the rice to be auctioned will be displayed at 9.00 am on the day of the auction.

**Terms and Conditions of the sale:**

- A.
- (i) The intending bidder can get their Applications from the Department of Civil Supplies and consumers Affairs, Puducherry after paying the application fee of **Rs.1,000/-** on all working days from **06.10.2015 to 26.10.2015**.
  - (ii) The intending bidder is at his liberty to quote for any lot (s) required.
  - (iii) Applications not accompanied by the required amount of Earnest Money Deposit or any other required documents are liable to be summarily rejected and any application received after **3.00 pm on 27.10.2015** will not be considered. **The date of commencement of auction is at 3.00 p.m. on 29.10.2015 in the Chamber of the Director, Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry.**
  - (iv) The details of the confiscated rice, stocked lot wise, Approximate quantity of rice in each lot, assessed value of the rice for lot, EMD amount for the lot, date and time of commencement of the open auction are furnished in the Schedule I.
  - (v) The confiscated rice mentioned in the schedule-II will be auctioned on such date and time mentioned in the Schedule-I one after another and they shall be continued until the offers of the cease.
  - (vi) The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry may withdraw any lot from the auction at any time or cancel the same at any stage prior to the delivery of the goods.
- B.
- i). The confiscated rice stocks put up for sale through **Open auction** strictly in the same condition as they lie on "**As is where basis “and” No Complaint basis**". All quantities are only approximate and without any guarantee. The stocks of the confiscated rice can be inspected by the intending bidder with the prior approval of the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry between **10.00 a.m to 4.00 p.m** on all working days from **06.10.2015 to 26.10.2015** at Central Ware Housing Corporation, Vanarapet, Uppalam, Puducherry from where the delivery of the consignment will be given and is limited to visual checking only. They shall be removed by the highest bidder / buyer) within the period specified in the delivery order, with all the defects if any and notwithstanding any error or mis-statements of description, measurement, quantity weight, enumeration or otherwise and without any objection on the part of the buyer and no claim shall lie against the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs , Puducherry for compensation nor shall any allowance be made on the account of such faults, mis-statements, errors that the same may be of considerable nature. The buyer should satisfy himself thoroughly as to what is offered for sale before submitting his application and may inspect the confiscated rice stock prior to offering their bids and shall be deemed (whether or not such inspection shall have in fact taken place) to have had notice of all defects and faults and any error, any mis-statement as aforesaid which he might have discovered on inspection shall not be entitled to claim or recover from the other any compensation by way of damage or otherwise if the quantity or if confiscated rice stocks sold are not available by reasons of not being at the specified place.

ii). The Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry reserves the right to withdraw from the sale of any lot / lots included in the sale notice prior to the issue of confirmation of sale intimation letter or prior to the issue of the delivery order of any such lot/lots without assigning any reason. Any clarification required may be sought by the intending bidders from the Director, Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry at the time of inspection, and no dispute regarding the confiscated rice or its physical conditions.

iii).The Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry shall not guarantee to make any definite quality or quantity of the confiscated rice stocks available to the bidder / buyer.

C. Any Rice miller, Retail / wholesale Rice Merchants / Dealers or Firm desiring to participate in the auction **shall furnish the following certificates along with the application** to the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry on or before **3.00 pm on 27.10.2015**.

(i) Earnest Money Deposit equivalent mentioned in the Schedule- II shall be paid by way of Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque drawn from any Nationalized Bank at the time and date of the submission of the application for consideration.

(ii) Copies of Income Tax PAN card and latest Income Tax Return,

(iii) Sales Tax Registration Certificate, latest Income Tax Return,

(iv) Copy of the Trade License of the intending bidder

(v) Copies of Turnover of the firm for the last three consequent years.

(vi) Certificate for any concession / relaxation for payment of EMD

(vii) Photograph and specimen signature of the bidder.

(viii) In the case of firm, the person signing the application or any other documents forming part of the auction on behalf of firm, shall produce a proper power of Attorney duly executed in his favour stating that he/she has authority to bind such other person in all matters pertaining to the contract.

D. The intending bidders, signing the Tender should state in what capacity he/ she is signing the application (i.e.,) sole Proprietor of a firm, or Secretary, Managing Director, etc., of a limited company. In case of partnership firm, the application should be signed by all partners. The person signing the application form or other documents on behalf of another person shall produce a proper Power of Attorney duly executed in his/her favour stating that he/she had authority to bind such other person in all matters pertaining to the disposal of the said confiscated rice and any application without enclosing the Power of Attorney will be rejected. The Power of Attorney should be signed by all partners in case of partnership concern and in case of limited companies and also it should be under the common seal of the company.

E. (i) The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry is not responsible for any unforeseen external disturbances preventing the intending bidder from participating in the open auction.

**(ii) The auction shall commence at the time and on the date indicated in Schedule-I. Tenderer / bidder can offer their bid amount on kilogram basis and the starting bid amount should not be less than Rs.2/-, the assessed value of the rice per kilogram. Tenderer / Bidder, can go on revising his bid amount so as to improve upon the same on per kilogram basis and they shall be continued until the offers of the cease.**

F. After the rice in seven lots or any lot thus auctioned, the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry may provisionally accept and communicate the confirmation of sale intimation letter to the highest bidder. The acceptance of a bid by the Officer conducting the sale of confiscated rice shall be subject to the confirmation by the Government. The order of the confirmation or refusal to confirm shall be communicated to the concerned highest bidder within a reasonable time.

G. i). Once the Confirmation of Sale Intimation letter is issued to the highest bidder by e-mail/letter, the EMD amount paid by him/her will be considered as the Security Deposit which will be returned after completion of the lifting process of the entire rice from the godown of the Central Ware Housing Corporation, Puducherry or will be forfeited in the event of the failure of complying conditions of the sale notice. The Earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded / returned by the Government to the concerned bidders.

ii). **The successful/highest bidder should pay the entire bid amount** awarded to the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry by way of Demand draft or Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs, Puducherry within 7 days of the issue of the acceptance order in respect of the lot (s).

iii). After receipt of the entire bid amount from the highest bidder(buyer), delivery order will be issued by the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs, Puducherry and the bidder should lift the entire stock from the Central Ware Housing Corporation, Puducherry within 15 days of the issue of the delivery order.

iv). The request of the highest bidder(Buyer) may be considered to adjust his EMD amount which was considered as Security Deposit after issue of the confirmation of sale intimation letter in case, if the bidder,

(a) paid the entire balance amount bid within the stipulated period along with the applicable Duties and Taxes, other amounts required and including the cost of the gunny bags.

(b) lifted the entire stock within the stipulated time from the godown of the Central Ware House Corporation, Puducherry.

H. The highest bidder should lift the entire quantity of rice from the Central Ware Housing Corporation, Puducherry within the stipulated period following the Terms and conditions of the sale notice at his own cost and risk and no remission shall be granted in case of damage of rice in the godown, or loss at the time of lifting and transportation of rice at the risk of the bidder.

I. If the Highest Bidder fails to pay the entire bid amount along with applicable Duties and taxes or fails to lift the entire stock or partly within the stipulated period or to comply any conditions of the auction notice/procedure, the following actions will be taken:

(i) The highest bidder will be considered as defaulted bidder.

(ii) The EMD amount paid by the defaulted bidder will be forfeited and remitted into the Government Account.

(iii) The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry reserve the right to invite the willingness/acceptance of the second highest bidder of the said lot and if the second highest bidder submitted his willingness letter to purchase the said lot, to the rate offered by him, the confirmation of the sale intimation will be issued to him/her after receipt of the entire bid amount with applicable Duties and Taxes the entire said stock(said lot) will be sold to him/her and the defaulted bidder is liable to pay the entire differential amount to the Government in the event of dispose of the said lot rice to the second highest bidder.

(iv) In case, if the second highest bidder not submitted his willingness letter to purchase the said rice, the same unsold lot will be brought to re-auction with the reduction of upset price at the sole discretion of the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry and the defaulted bidder is liable to pay all the expenditure and loss incurred to the Government.

(v) The defaulted bidder( buyer) is also liable to pay the entire highest bid amount offered by him in case, if no bidder participated and offered any bid in the re-auction conducted by the Director, Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Puducherry for disposal and if the quality and suitability of the rice deteriorated and not disposed of.

(vi). The defaulted bidder is also liable to pay the rent towards the storage charges( Rent rates fixed by the CWC) to the Director of the Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry from the date of the issue of the confirmation of the sale intimation letter to till the disposal of the confiscated rice which in turn has to be paid to the Central Ware Housing Corporation, Puducherry.

(vii) If the Tenderer fails or neglects to observe or perform any of his obligations under the contract it shall be lawful for the Director (CS&CA) to pay to adjust either in whole or in its absolute discretion the Security Deposit furnished by the tenderer or any part thereof, towards the satisfaction of any sum due to the claim from the tenderer for any damages, losses, charges, expenses or cost that may be suffered or incurred by the Director (CS&CA). The decision of the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry in this regard shall be final and binding on the tenderer.

(viii) The defaulted bidder is also liable other all charges such as administrative charges, advertisement charges, etc, incurred by the Government.

J. The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, postpone the auction to any other day notified by him. The un-disposed lots of rice shall be disposed of by the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry after fixing another date.

K. The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry may, for any special reason, may permit the highest bidder to lift the stock even after expiry of the stipulated time subject to condition that the highest bidder should pay the penal amount at the rate of **Rs.100/- per each 1000 kg of rice** and after collecting rent to be paid to the CWC.

L. (i) Delayed payment may be accepted, depending on the circumstances of the case or urgency of disposal with such penalty @ Rs.100/- per each 1000 Kg of rice and after collecting rent towards storage charges or as may be deemed fit. The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry also reserve the right to accept the request of the defaulted bidder in case, if the defaulted bidder submitted his request letter and paid the entire bid amount along with penal amount and rent and also assurance letter stating that he/she will lift the entire stock from CWC godown point within the stipulated time.

(ii) In case, considering the willingness letter of the second highest bidder of the said lot, if the entire bid amount is collected and Sale order/delivery order issued by the Director of Civil Supplies, the request of the defaulted bidder cannot be accepted Or

(iii) In case, for the disposal of the said lot rice, if the re-auction commenced, any request of the default bidder will not be considered.

- M. (i) The stock shall be weighted under Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry arrangements and delivery will be by net weight. The weightment sheets shall be prepared in triplicate and shall be signed by the buyer or his representative and an Officer authorized by the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry.
- (ii) At the time of giving delivery, if there is shortfall in the declared quantity, proportionate refund to the bidder (buyer) will be allowed on presentation of a duly supported proof within a time frame as decided by the Director, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs. On the other hand, if the stock is found to be excess, proportionate additional payment shall be made by the buyer in the same manner as referred to above before lifting the stock from the godown of the CWC, Puducherry.
- (iii) The bidder (buyer) should make his own arrangements for transport and will not be entitled to claim any facility or assistance for transport from the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry. The buyer will be responsible for handling including stacking of bags in the trucks/ wagons.
- N. If the original buyer wish to take delivery of the rice stock through his/her representative he must authorize the latter by a letter of authority which shall be presented to the Tahsildar (Squad Section), Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry. The said Officer may in his entire discretion decline to act on any such authority and it shall be in all case of the bidder (buyer) to satisfy such Officer that the authority is genuine. Delivery by the proxy shall be at purchaser's sole responsibility and risk and no claim shall lie against the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry on any account, wherever delivery is effected to a wrong person.
- O. The cost of the bags are not included in the assessment value and the intending bidder should pay **Rs. 5/- per each gunny bag**.
- P. The stock sold to the highest bidder (buyer) shall be at the risk of the highest bidder from the date of issue of confirmation letter to the highest bidder and the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry shall not be responsible for the safe custody or preservation thereof.
- Q. The buyer shall also be liable to pay storage charges as decided and communicated by the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry. These charges will be recovered in respect of the entire quantities of the un-lifted stocks at the end of the period before the delivery of such stocks is actually effected or till the date of release (inclusive). Delivery would be given only during working hours on all working days.
- R. The Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry reserves the right to extend the period of delivery or release order and the bidder(buyer) shall not be entitled to any compensation for such extension of the period of delivery.
- S. The confiscated rice which was disposed of by way of auction should not be sold for human consumption directly, unless tested and certified suitable for human consumption.
- T. (i) It is absolutely necessary that the bidder (buyer) should send the samples for testing and after obtaining Suitability Certificate for human consumption, the said rice should be sold in the market and shall also make no attempt what so ever for adulteration or misuse of the stocks. The Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry will take a serious view against breach of these conditions of sale.
- (ii) It will also not be open to the bidder (buyer) to question the categorization of the stocks as shown in the sale notice.



U. The Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry do not have any responsibility for obtaining permits from the State Government in favour of the buyer nor do they accept any liability for dispatching the stocks by rail in the absence of any permit.

V. Failure on the part of the highest bidder (buyer) to render full and satisfactory account of utilization of the rice stocks will constitute a breach of the contract and in such cases the buyer shall be liable to pay the all charges of damage/loss to be decided by the Director of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Puducherry.

W. Bidder shall have no right to issue any addendum to these Special Terms and Conditions or Buyer Specific Terms and Conditions to clarify, amend, supplement or delete any of the conditions, clauses or items stated therein.

X. The buyer shall not sublet, transfer or assign the contract or any part thereof, without the previous written approved of the Director, Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Puducherry.
